



LOW FLOW TOILETS REDUCE COST BY 53% IN 80-YEAR-OLD BUILDING

The Jane Apartments, located in Greenbelt, Maryland, replaced their existing toilets with 0.8 GPF toilets and realized a 47% reduction in water usage and 53% reduction in costs.

OVER 80 YEARS OLD

Aqua Savers, a company that specializes in retrofitting water-efficient products in multifamily properties, completed a water efficiency program the Jane Apartments at the end of August 2021. The 52-unit, three story property was built in 1937 and serves the local community with affordable housing.

THE PRODUCTS

Aqua Savers replaced the old, high flow toilets with Niagara's The OriginalTM model that flushes at 0.8 GPF. THE RESULTS
